| Distance | 8.25 miles/12.3 km |

| Route | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cross road and head Southwest down wide path ● Pass two ponds, head sough and walk along edge of first wood ● Enter next wood and walk through next two woods on path ● Exit wood and walk along the edge of Park Wood before heading north ● Walk into Bramfield, head east, then north through Great Gobions Farm ● Head north through fields until returning to Watton-at-Stone Station |
| Lunch/ refreshments | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Lunch at Bramfield Village Hall Playing fields with benches ● Packed lunch and water to last day |
